Please care about trees everywhere.

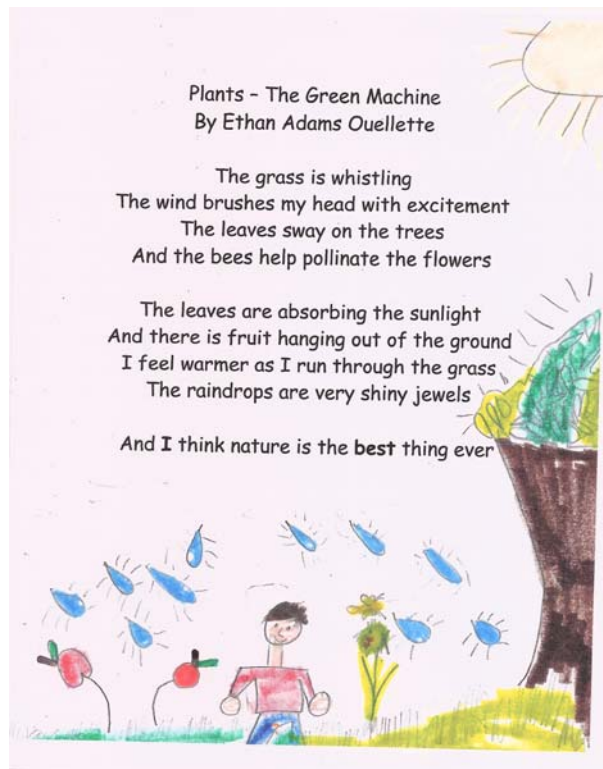
