Mission Statement	The Committee on International Activities is a resource for proactively advocating, catalyzing, initiating, and implementing ACS international activities, including global conferences, and initiatives pertaining to education and research & development of broad scientific understanding, appreciation of chemistry, and promotion of the image of chemistry. This will happen in collaboration with other national and international organizations.
Normal Meeting Schedule	Semiannually, at each national meeting. The full Committee generally meets all day on the Saturday proceeding the meeting week. IAC Subcommittees (Americas, Europe, Asia / Pacific Basin and Africa / Middle East) convene throughout the year in web-based meetings and telephone conference calls.
Reimbursement Policy	ACS will reimburse non-Councilor committee members, associates, and consultants for reasonable, ordinary and necessary transportation, lodging, and meal expenses incurred by attending meetings of Council-related committees at national meetings, up to an amount equal to 50% of the amount Councilors can be reimbursed under the Non-Councilor Travel Expense Program. For Councilors, reimbursement is provided through the Councilors Travel Expense Program. If necessary, ACS will reimburse certain travel expenses incurred due to authorized committee meetings and work performed outside of national meetings.
