The previous years were focused on the 2016 SERMACS meeting held by the South Carolina Section in Columbia, SC. We had monthly meetings that quickly changed to weekly meetings as we approached the event. Our SERMACS meeting was very successful because of the incredible amount of work from the section volunteers. After the meeting was completed there were several wrap-up sessions and work began on the 2016 SERMACS Final Report. The report was constructed via web conference meetings and emails and presented at the 2017 SERMACS weeting in Charlotte. Aside from the post SERMACS work, the section sponsored a speaker at USC on climate change and held our Annual Awards meeting at Claflin University. Both events were very well attended. Hosting the speaker at USC was very successful and I agree with the rest of the committee that sponsoring events at local colleges and universities might be our most efficient and useful means of outreach for the ACS. It was a pleasure to serve as Chair for the past two years and I thank the executive committee members for their support and hard work. I especially want to thank Dr. Jim Deavor, who as Treasurer, did an amazing job in every aspect of our Section and the SERMACS meeting.
