## International Year of Chemistry 2011: Materials and Health Community Engagement Webinar for Tuesday, May 24

#### Pennies for PUR fundraising initiative

As part of the International Year of Chemistry 2011 celebration, ACS launched Pennies for PUR™ Water. This effort raises funds to purchase and distribute PUR™ water sachets to people in developing countries that lack safe drinking water. The goal of this fundraising effort is to provide 1.5 million gallons of safe drinking water by the end of 2011. All ACS members and local sections are encouraged to donate and to work in their communities to raise money for this initiative. What better way for improving public recognition and appreciation of the contributions of chemistry than using chemistry to provide safe water to the 1 billion people in the world that don't have it.
