


# American Chemical Society Western Michigan Section March, 2015 Newsletter

Plans are finalized for the West Michigan Section to host the Central Regional Meeting with the Kalamazoo Section in 2015. On May 27-30 of 2015 the Great Lakes and Central Regions of the American Chemical Society have the privilege of hosting a Joint Regional Meeting at the Amway Grand Plaza Hotel and DeVos Place in downtown Grand Rapids, Michigan.
