



**The AICCS invites applications for a Young Investigator Award in Glycosciences. Successful candidates will present their work at the National Carbohydrate Symposium in Banff, Alberta (May 5-7, 2011)!**

The Alberta Ingenuity Centre for Carbohydrate Sciences (AICCS) welcomes applications for the **AICCS Young Investigator Award in Glycosciences**. This award is intended to encourage carbohydrate research by young investigators around the world. The recipient of this award will be invited to present, together with top carbohydrate scientists, at the 7th National Carbohydrate Symposium that will be held on May 5-7, 2011 in Banff, Alberta, Canada, one of the world's most beautiful settings. The award covers your registration, your accommodation and meals in Banff, as well as economy air fare and other travel expenses up to CAD \$1500.00 to attend and present at the symposium.

To be eligible to compete for this award, you must be a full-time graduate student or post-doctoral researcher at any academic institution in the world, working on a project focused on any aspect of glyco-biology and/or carbohydrate chemistry.
