Fifty Years in Chemistry: What an Adventure!

I never would have guessed the last fifty years (1972-2022) would have allowed me to get to know the people I have, to travel as much as I have, and accomplish what I have in Chemistry. In this talk, I will attempt to share what motivated me to pursue a career as a faculty member; how I have developed as a teacher; why did the research I have done; and the privilege it has been to share life with thousands of students, faculty and staff.



Bruce Alan Hathaway was born in San Diego, California. The son of a career US Navy officer, he moved eight times in his first fourteen years, before his father retired. He graduated from L. D. Bell High School in Hurst, Texas, in 1972, and from the University of Texas at Austin, with a B. S. degree in Chemistry, with honors, in 1976. He graduated from Purdue University with a Ph.D. in Medicinal Chemistry, in 1980. He spent two years doing post-doctoral work in Medicinal Chemistry with Corwin Hansch at Pomona College in Claremont, California, and obtained a Chemistry faculty position at Southeast Missouri State University in 1982. He rose through the ranks, was promoted to full professor in 1997, and received post-professorial merit in 2003. Since 2010, he has been a professor of Chemistry at LeTourneau University, and served as chair of the Department of Chemistry and Physics from 2018-2021.
